New Phase



An Interaction With Our Principal



The interview team, comprising students from various departments—Muhammed Farzin (I BSc Psychology), Ameensha (I BA), Aameena Shaikha (I BCom Finance), and Ansira Fathima (I BSc Psychology), had been diligently preparing their questions to interview the Principal to be featured in the fourth issue of the newsletter—“Peekay Bytes.”

The Principal welcomed the team and transformed the planned one-to-one interview into an engaging interactive session. His approach provided the students with lasting inspiration and meaningful insights. He also appreciated that all the participants were first-year students who had approached the session with enthusiasm and aspiration.

The interaction began with the Principal asking what motivated the team to interview him. Responding to this, Ameensha explained that the college had achieved remarkable growth and success in a short period, largely due to his leadership, and they wished to understand the journey behind this success.

The Principal shared that he had over twenty-five years of experience at a reputed college in Kerala, where he eventually served as Principal, before he was asked to be the Principal at Peekay CICS Arts and Science College. He emphasised that leadership is an art that involves guiding others, setting direction, and collaborating. As the head of an institution, he highlighted the importance of caring for students and stakeholders. He compared the functioning of the institution to a pyramid, where responsibilities are structured hierarchically, ensuring smooth functioning. He also used the analogy of a sieve, explaining how collective effort helps filter and address challenges effectively.

Ansira then raised a question about managing stress amidst responsibilities. The Principal responded that authority inevitably brings responsibility, and with it, stress. However, one must not avoid responsibilities but learn to face them. He stressed the importance of observation, learning from real-

life experiences, and effective planning, both short-term and long-term. He also noted that personal development varies among individuals, with each person progressing at their own pace.

Reflecting on the college’s growth, he mentioned that despite being only thirteen years old, the institution has established a strong reputation among the ninety colleges in Kozhikode district. Achievements such as defeating Devagiri College in football stand as milestones of collective effort. He emphasised that academic excellence remains a priority, with the introduction of relevant and in-demand courses such as BCA, BSc Psychology, Data Science, and most recently, BSc Artificial Intelligence. He also highlighted the importance of mathematics as a valuable skill across disciplines.

When asked by Farzin about the most touching moment in his professional life, the Principal stated that being the head of an institution involves careful monitoring and addressing issues sensitively. He noted with satisfaction that disciplinary issues are minimal and often resolved amicably, with students learning from their mistakes and later contributing positively to the institution. He had several examples to cite about the disciplined students who later do well in their life and those are the cherished moments.

To the question put forward by Aameena on what his advice would be to the present generation of students, he encouraged students to value and respect their parents and teachers, emphasising that genuine happiness lies in sincere relationships. He urged students to express gratitude, build meaningful connections, and face life with courage. To build good communication skills and be bold in expressing one’s opinions and ideas. He concluded with a powerful message: self-discipline is the true path to success. The team then left, expressing heartfelt gratitude to the Principal for a wonderful interactive session.

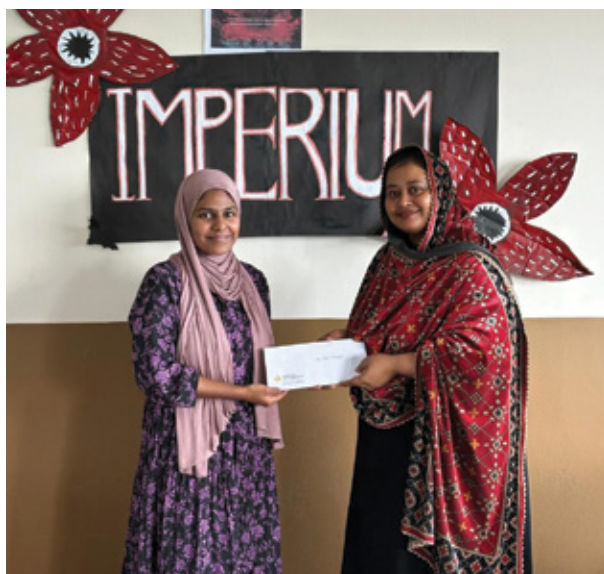

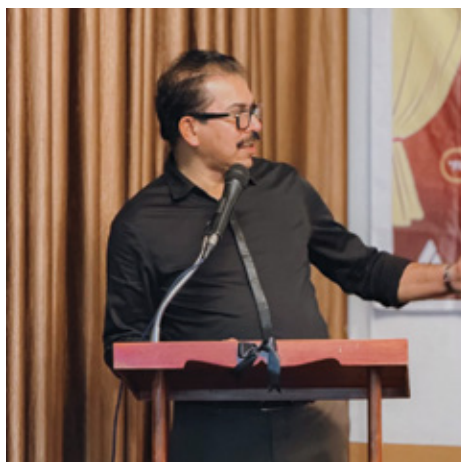

B- GYAAN: IMPERIUM 'the Management Fest' organised the Biz Quiz on 29th Jan.

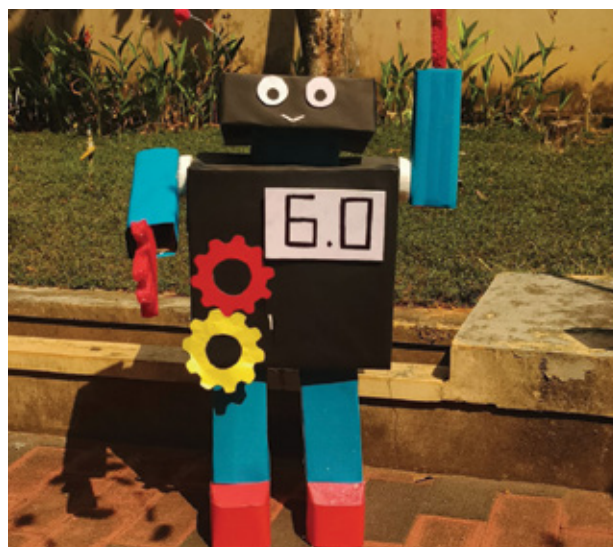
